1. Welcome & Introduction

Outdoor Portofino welcomed the participants and introduced the objectives of the meeting. A brief round of introductions allowed all attendees to reconnect and align on the project's final phase.

2. Project Progress & Local Activities

Each partner presented a summary of the local activities implemented since the last transnational meeting. Emphasis was placed on good practices, levels of participation, and how sport and sustainability were integrated into community engagement.

3. Review of all products on the website

All outputs currently published on the project website were reviewed. Small adjustments were proposed to improve consistency and visibility across partner sections.

4. Collection of dissemination-related documents

Partners were reminded to send all dissemination materials for documentation purposes. This will support final reporting and impact measurement—review of Europe platform.

5. Discussion of the last WP4 task (Deadline: May 31)

The group reviewed the final deliverable required under WP4, referencing the application

form for guidance. Example formats were discussed, and each partner committed to submitting their contributions by the deadline to complete the final output.
